MUSKEGO ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION Co-ed T-Ball Baseball League Specific Rules – Ages 4-5 REVISED 5/2024

- 1. 60 foot base paths. Pitcher's plate will not be used.
- 2. A Softee-ball T-ball will be used for game play.
- 3. Bats must be 2" barrel diameter maximum.
- 4. Game scores and team standings will not be kept.
- 5. Up to five coaches may be used during games. Up to two outfield coaches can be used during game play.
- 6. All regular season games will be played on Thursday evenings at 5:30pm and will last at maximum of 55 minutes or 5 innings, whichever comes first. All innings will be finished and no new inning will start after 6:25pm.
- 7. All players will bat each inning.
- 8. Team will field 10-12 players (one catcher, one pitcher, four infielders and four-five outfielders).
- 9. No bunting allowed.
- 10. No stealing or leading off.
- 11. No infield fly rule is enforced.
- 12. The pitcher position must stand in the pitching mound area until the batter hits the ball.
- 13. The offensive coach, with the batter, may only touch the batter to position proper stance.
- 14. A batted ball must pass the front of the batters box for the ball to be in play. Coaches discretion if the batters box is no longer visible.
- 15. All bats must be dropped after hitting the ball or the batter will be called out.
- 16. Base runners must stay in the base paths.
- 17. No runners may advance on an overthrow to any base.
- 18. The ball is considered dead and no advance can be made by any runner when the ball is thrown home and crosses an imaginary line between first and third base.
- 19. This applies, regardless if the ball is caught by the catcher. This rule only applies when the ball is hit to the outfield.
- 20. The batter and base runner must avoid contact with defensive players.
- 21. The coaches shall stop play once judged that play is over. Offensive coaches shall not create a play by encouraging runners to advance.
- 22. Sliding is allowed.
- 23. Because sliding is allowed, all players must wear pants, NO SHORTS.
