Senior Baseball League Rules

LEAGUE SPECIFIC

These rules are in addition to the MAA General Rules of Baseball and designed to allow an age/skill appropriate game for the Senior Baseball league.

GENERAL:

1. Base paths will be 90 feet.
2. The pitcher's plate will be set at 60'6" feet from the back point of home plate.
3. A continuous batting order will be used.
4. Bats must be standard BBCOR drop-3
5. The dropped third strike rule will be enforced. With less than two outs and first base occupied, the batter is called out and cannot advance to first base. The runners may advance at their own risk. With two outs, the batter and runners may advance at their own risk.
6. A post season tournament may be scheduled at the league chair's discretion. Any special rules of tournament play shall be provided by the league chair.
7. No designated or extra hitter rule will be used.
8. Slaughter rule – 10 run lead after 5
th inning.
9. Managers must provide their line-up including jersey number and player name to the opposing manager prior to the beginning of the game.
10. Time limit will be enforced. No new inning will start after 2 1/4 hours.
11. If a batter shows bunt before a pitch he must bunt or pull back and take the pitch. No swinging is allowed if a batter is showing bunt. If a play swings after showing bunt, he will be called out.

PITCHING:

1. Balks WILL BE CALLED. There will be no balk warning.
2. Pitchers are limited to 100 pitches per game

BASE RUNNING:

1. Base stealing is allowed; there are no limitations per WIAA rules.
2. A runner must slide at home plate on close plays to minimize collisions or the runner will be called out. The runner's feet must stay below the catcher's knees on the slide or the runner will be called out.
